These are the priorities we worked on last year.

- *To improve calculation skills across the school. Pupils made good progress. Big Maths has had a strong impact on nearly all children's skills. This is shown in their personalised assessments
- *To develop a clear understanding of the language of learning.

Following monitoring, children made strong progress in their ability to discuss their learning with confidence and clarity. This was particularly strong in Maths.

- *To improve non-fiction writing from years 3-6 Talk for writing approach where children practise their writing orally before writing was implemented across the school. Children's understanding and detailed writing was improved.
- *To ensure a calm school environment throughout the school day.
