



School Uniform Policy

As a school we have high standards for all our pupils and the wearing of school uniform is one of the things that we want our children to take pride in, as it contributes to a good attitude to learning and self-confidence. At the same time we still want our children to be individuals and we achieve this through the curriculum and out of school activities. We hope as parents that you will support our school uniform policy and understand our reasons for reinforcing it.

What is the uniform at Carreghofa Primary School?

Girls

All Year

Sky Blue Polo Shirt
Royal Blue Sweatshirt or cardigan preferably with school badge
Navy skirt / trousers / pinafore / shorts
White or Navy Socks OR Navy tights
Appropriate plain, flat, black footwear

Summer

Blue / white check dress
Navy shorts/Culottes
Appropriate white or dark coloured flat sandals

Boys

All Year

Sky Blue Polo Shirt
Royal Blue Sweatshirt preferably with school badge
Navy trousers or shorts
Navy, Grey or black socks
Appropriate plain, flat, black footwear

Summer

Navy shorts / trousers
Appropriate dark coloured flat sandals or black shoes

What do we wear for P.E.

Sky Blue round neck t-shirt
Navy shorts
Plain jogging bottoms – Navy
Trainers / pumps – white or black
Hair bobble to tie long hair back

Can my child wear jewellery to school?

On health and safety grounds we do not allow children to wear jewellery in our school other

than 1 pair of studded gold/silver earrings. We ask children to either remove these or cover them during PE, to prevent them from causing injury. No makeup, including nail varnish should be worn, or body tattoos.

How Can We Order School Uniform?

Please complete an order form found in Reception. Clothes usually arrive within seven days. Payment is required when ordering. Due to limited space we will no longer be holding a stock of uniform.

What happens if my child does not wear full school uniform?

We do understand that there may be exceptional or extenuating circumstances when your child may be unable to wear school uniform on a particular day. If this happens, it is expected that parents will write a simple note to the classroom teacher or head teacher explaining the circumstances.

If a child persistently does not wear the correct school uniform, the governors have agreed to the following action:-

Step 1: Second hand uniform will be provided for the day.

Step 2: A courtesy letter will be sent out to the parent reminding them of the school uniform policy.

Help and Support

We are really keen to work with our parents to ensure that our school uniform policy benefits everyone. We hold a selection of good quality second hand uniform which is free to anyone who would like to browse through our stock.

We can only reinforce that in order for our school uniform policy to be effective and fair we are keen to offer any help and support that we can.
